DONKEY LANE (BOLNHURST AND KEYSOE BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 53)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any mechanically propelled vehicle (other than a motor cycle) or horse drawn carriage from proceeding along Donkey Lane (Bolnhurst and Keysoe BOAT No 53) from its junction with Keysoe Row East at OS GR TL 0907 6182 for approx 2380m to St Neots Road, Bolnhurst at OS GR TL 0972 6015.

This closure is required to prevent damage to the surface of the lane. The closure follows an emergency made on 1st April 2024 and will continue from Tuesday 23rd April 2024 up to six months.

There is no alternative route for users while the closure is in operation.

The Order will come into operation on 23rd April 2024 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
