(CROSS END LANE (THURLEIGH: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 49)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that the order made by Bedford Borough Council on the 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023 the effect of which will be to prohibit any person driving any mechanically propelled vehicle other than motor cycle or horse drawn carriage along Thurleigh BOAT No 49 known as Cross End Lane which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0629 5884 to OS GR TL 0629 5993 has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 11<sup>th</sup> October 2024.

**This temporary closure is required to prevent damage to the surface of the lane.**

**The closure will take place from Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024.**

There is no alternative route vehicles while the closure is in operation.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
