



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN CHURCH LANE, RISELEY.

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council proposes to remove existing School Children Keep Clear markings and introduce new parking restrictions along Church Lane, Riseley. The corrections are in accordance with planning requirement for the new development.

Effect of the Order.

- 1. To introduce 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following length of road:**

A	Church Lane, Riseley
(i)	On its south - eastern kerb extending from the projected centre of Kings Close for a distance of approx. 101 metres in a south westerly direction.

- 2. To revoke existing 'School Children Keep Clear' restrictions on the following length of road:**

A	Church Lane, Riseley
(i)	On its south – eastern kerb from a point approx. 43 metres south west of the centre of Kings Close extending for a distance of approx. 58 metres in a south westerly direction.
