This Order is made by the Bedford Borough Council ("the authority") under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated in the environs of Hall End Farm, Hall End Road, in the Parish of Wootton and shown by a bold continuous line between Points A to B on the map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 7 (seven) days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, in respect of their apparatus under, in, upon, over, along or across the said land as they had immediately before the date of confirmation of this Order.
3. This order may be cited as the "Bedford Borough Council (Wootton: Footpath No.10) Public Path Extinguishment Order 2021".

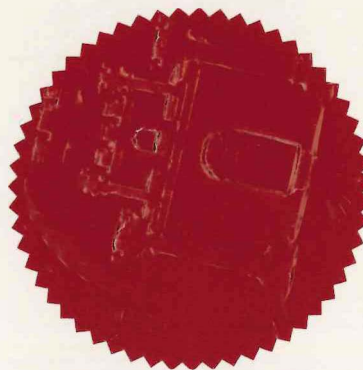
