

#### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

# BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN SOUTHCOTE, SHORTSTOWN

### **Reason for Proposal:**

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Shortstown Parish Council for new parking restrictions in Southcote, Shortstown. This is in response to inconsiderate parking at this location, when an adjacent parking area is provided.

## **Effect of the Proposal:**

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

Α	Southcote, Shortstown
(i)	On its north-eastern and then continuing on its north-western kerb, from its junction with Greycote to a point approx. 98 metres south-west of the
	projected centre line of the entrance to Shortstown Village Hall car park (the
	base of the traffic calming chicane).
(ii)	On its eastern and southern kerb, from a point approx. 7.5 metres south-east
	of the south-eastern side of Greycote, extending in a southerly (clock-wise)
	direction to the extent of adopted highway at the entrance to Shortstown
	Village Hall car park.
(iii)	On its southern kerb, from the extent of adopted highway at the entrance to
	Shortstown Village Hall car park, extending in a northerly and then westerly
	direction to a point approx. 26 metres west of the projected centre line of the
	entrance to Shortstown Village Hall car park.
(iv)	On its south-eastern kerb, extending from a point approx. 80 metres south-
	west of the projected centre line of the entrance to Shortstown Village Hall car
	park for a distance of approx. 18 metres in a south-westerly direction (to the
	base of the traffic calming chicane).
