



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO FORMALISE A DISABLED PERSONS PARKING BAY IN BEAUVAIS SQUARE, SHORTSTOWN

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received complaints about vehicles using a marked disabled persons parking bay in Beauvais Square, Shortstown without displaying a Blue Badge. As such, Bedford Borough Council propose to make an Order which will formalise this disabled persons parking bay and enable the enforcement of the parking restriction.

Effect of the Order:

1. To formalise the disabled persons parking bay at the following location:

A	Beauvais Square, Shortstown
(i)	On the south-eastern kerb of the southern leg of Beauvais Square, extending from a point approx.35 metres southwest of Rochester Way, for 6.6 metres in a south westerly direction.

A copy of this Notice, a draft Order, a plan, and a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, MK42 9AP, and will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
