



## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE NEW PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN WOOD LANE & MEETING CLOSE, COTTON END**

#### **Reason for Proposal:**

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from Councillors for extensions to existing parking restrictions in Wood Lane at Cotton End. This is in response to concerns raised over inconsiderate parking at these locations which affects visibility and safety, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

#### **Effect of the Order:**

1. To extend existing 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

<b>A</b>	<b>Wood Lane, Cotton End</b>
(i)	On both sides, from a point approx. 15 metres east of its junction with A600 High Road (the end of the existing 'No waiting at any time' restriction) extending for a distance of approx. 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
(ii)	On its western kerb, from its junction with Meeting Close to a point approx. 10 metres north-west of the projected north-western side of Meeting Close.
<b>B</b>	<b>Meeting Close, Cotton End</b>
(i)	On its north-western kerb, from its junction with Wood Lane extending for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a south-westerly direction.
(ii)	On its south-eastern kerb, extending from the end of the existing 'No waiting at any time' restriction to a point approx. 10 metres south-west of its junction with Wood Lane.
