2. On the 7th day of FEBRUARY 2019 I, Alan Edward Tinsley Barcock for F.P. Tinsley Estate deposited with Bedford Borough Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a map showing the extent of the F.P. Tinsley Estate edged red which stated that:


