

Notice of Making a Modification Order Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 Bedford Borough Council

Definitive Map and Statement for The Former North Bedfordshire Borough

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE FORMER NORTH BEDFORDSHIRE BOROUGH) (STAGSDEN: PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY No. 36) MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

The above Order, made on 16 May 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a length of Public Bridleway in the Parish of Stagsden to be numbered 36 in the Definitive Statement that commences where it has a junction with that part of the Public Road known as "Newport Pagnell Road" in Stagsden approximately 416 metres west of the residential property known as "3 Ducksworth Farm," Stagsden at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SP 9614/4761 shown as Point A on the map attached to this order (Appendix 1) then running in a generally south-east direction, following the administrative boundary with Astwood (Milton Keynes) for approximately 1085 metres to that part of Public Footpath number 4, Stagsden to be retained at OSGR SP 9656/4673 shown as Point B on the map attached to this order (Appendix 1) then continuing in a generally south-east direction following the administrative boundary with Astwood (Milton Keynes) for approximately 906 metres until it reaches a connection with Bridleway 34 Kempston Rural shown as Point C on the map attached to this Order (Appendix 2) at OSGR SP 9715/4607
